About the Building

- Ark Royal House is a purpose built block of flats constructed of a steel frame, masonry walls, concrete floors and Ethylene Propylene Diene Monomer (EPDM) roof covering. The balconies are Juliette style and are constructed of steel, glass and have a "Alideck" base
- There is no cladding fitted to the building. There are spandrel (concealing the inner structure) panels under most windows. The central parts of the building are rendered.
- The building has 10 storeys and no basement. It consists of 57 self-contained flats .
- There is 1 protected staircase and 1 passenger lift.
- Accommodation is classed as general needs.

Read any information we send you on fire safety and make yourself aware of the fire safety notices present in your block and share these with other household members. Regularly test your smoke alarm.


